Importantly MiBT lets election managers catch and address ‘problem ballots’ before they become procedurally disruptive.

Optionally MiBT allows a county to web-publish this audit trail empowering each voter with the ability to track their by-mail ballot both during and after an election.

Bodin concluded, “Every voter is used to tracking their express delivery package as it makes its way to its final destination. MiBT enables that voter to track this very *special* package - their ballot!”
